Reduction Printing

In this unit pupils will....

- *Build up layers of colours*
- *Create a design using fine detail*
- *Show precision in techniques*



Background information

Reduction printing is a method of block printing where part of the block is removed as each new colour is printed on top of the last.

Knowledge and Understanding

In this unit pupils will learn how to create a design based on seedheads using the reduction printing process.



Key Artists:

Sophie Munns:

An Australian artist who creates drawings and prints inspired by seeds and seedheads.



Key Vocabulary:

Process: a series of things that are done in order to achieve a particular result

Incision: to make a cut into something

Inverted: an image that has been changed by turning it from top to bottom or left to right, to show the opposite of the original

Translate: moving a shape or image up or down or from side to side without changing it
