Supporters Code of Conduct

Dear Parent

School sport is an important part of children's education and the core values of the HDSA competitions are about sportsmanship and participation. Sport teaches self-discipline, perseverance, the importance of a healthy life style, respect for others and sportsmanship - the understanding that the game is more important than the result and that enjoying the game and playing with a spirit of fairness and friendliness are qualities that are important to foster.

It is with the above in mind that the Harpenden & District Primary Heads Consortium promotes a Supporters' Code of Conduct at all its competitive and non-competitive sports venues.

The consortium encourages and welcomes all supporters and expects the following courteous behaviour:

- 1. To encourage not criticise (and no coaching/direction)
- 2. To accept, without dissent, the decision of the referee or teacher in charge.
- 3. To promote positive language
- 4. To discourage inappropriate language
- 5. Not to take **photos or video** without the permission of the teacher in charge. We do have children at our events that have had to assume new identities for their safety; please do not breach this and put these children at risk.

We appreciate that you might be disappointed to learn that following Ofsted guidance on pupil safeguarding at host schools, parents/carers are welcome to support the events being held on school sites after 3.30pm (3.45pm on a secondary school site) but we would kindly request that you are not on the site during the school day. This does not apply to the Cross Country, tag rugby, cricket and district sports events when supporters are encouraged to attend for the whole event.

At all our sporting venues an appraisal of conduct will be considered. The consequences of any inappropriate behaviour will be communicated to the school/s in question and appropriate action will be taken. This may include one or more of the following:

- Individual requests for non-attendance at sporting venues this will always be precipitated by a letter from the Headteacher
- Season ban from one or more sporting event
- Void match (If the behaviour of any player, parent or supporter is not in line with the code of conduct, then the referee at the time has the right to call off the match and the team whom that supporter is watching would forfeit the match)
- Team disqualification
- Police involvement
